THIS WEEK'S HERO OF FAITH: Saint Richard, 1253, 16 June – was Bishop of Chichester for eight years in the mid-13th century. He is remembered for his kindness, humility and for being a model of holiness. He died on 3 April 1253, and his mortal remains were placed in Chichester Cathedral on 16 June 1276. Just nine years after his death, Richard was declared a saint. He is widely remembered for his prayer:

*Thanks be to thee, my Lord Jesus Christ,
for all the benefits thou hast given me,
for all the pains and insults thou hast borne for me.
O most merciful redeemer, friend and brother,
may I know thee more clearly, love thee more dearly,
and follow thee more nearly, day by day. Amen.*
