WELCOME: Welcome to this week's newsletter. Due to the Act of Remembrance in the Plaza at 10.55 am, **Sunday's service will start at 10.00 am.**

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY: During the Second World War, Armistice Day (11 November) was moved to the Sunday before the eleventh as an emergency measure. In May 1945, when the war in Europe ended, a conversation took place between the Christian denominations and the British Legion (it wasn't made 'Royal' until 1971), as to what day the fallen of both World Wars should be remembered. Cardinal Bernard Griffin, the then Roman Catholic Archbishop of Westminster, proposed that the second Sunday in November be renamed as 'Remembrance Sunday.' This suggestion was adopted in June 1946, and so the first Remembrance Sunday was 10 November 1946. It just so happened that 11 November 1945 fell on a Sunday,

THIS WEEK'S HERO OF FAITH: Saint Martin of Tours, Bishop, 397, 11 November — Born in modern-day Hungary, at about the age of 30, Martin's life changed, when as a soldier in the Roman Empire, he was riding his horse one cold winter's day and passed a beggar freezing to death. He stopped, dismounted, took off his heavy military cape and used his sword to cut a blanket-sized half to cover the beggar.

That same night, Martin saw the beggar in a dream, and warmed by the cape he had been given, the beggar looked up at him, and it was none other than Jesus himself. The following day Martin became a Christian, and declared, "I am a soldier of Jesus; it is not permissible me to fight."

After release from military service, Martin dedicated himself to service of Jesus Christ and the Church. He became a monk and then a bishop. It is most remarkable that his feast day falls on Armistice Day.
