WELCOME: Welcome to this week's newsletter.

ORDINARY TIME: Outside of Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week and Easter, Anglicans keep two seasons of *Ordinary Time*. The term comes from *ordinal* and means 'ordered or numbered time.'

The first starts on the *Monday after the Baptism of Christ* and ends on *Shrove Tuesday*. During this period, Sundays are numbered "*of Epiphany*" and "*before Lent*." The second begins on *Monday after Pentecost Sunday* and ends on the *Saturday before the First Sunday of Advent*. During this period, Sundays are numbered "*after Trinity*."

The liturgical colour for Ordinary Time is **green**, symbolizing renewal, growth, and life.

EXTRA-PROVINCIAL (E-P) CHURCHES: The Anglican Communion is a global family of national and regional independent Churches, all of which are in Communion with the Archbishop of Canterbury.

Forty of these are member churches, called '*Provinces*,' are under archbishops.

Five are called '*Extra-Provincial Churches*,' equivalent to dioceses, each with their own bishop (one has two), under the Archbishop of Canterbury.

The five E-P Churches are: *The Church of Ceylon*, *The Anglican Church of Bermuda*, *The Lusitanian Catholic Apostolic Evangelical Church*, *The Spanish Reformed Episcopal Church*, and *The Parish of the Falkland Islands*.

57TH SYNOD: Our bishop, Carlos, acts with the advice and consent of representatives of his clergy and elected lay people. Every two years, he holds a meeting called a synod, to discuss and vote on issues that concern the church. He has called a synod for 14-15 June. It will meet in Santiago de Compostella. Rev Richard and Andrew Briant will be attending.
