**WELCOME:** A warm welcome to this week's church newsletter. *A blessed Easter Season to you all.* 

**VE DAY:** Thursday 8 May marks the 80th anniversary of Victory in Europe Day (VE Day), which marks the official end of the Second World War in Europe. This Sunday, we conclude our service with a short act of commemoration to mark the anniversary.

**EASTER SEASON:** The season began on Easter Sunday and lasts 50 days. 40 days after Easter Sunday we celebrate Ascension Day, which is always a Thursday, but can be celebrated the following Sunday. The Season ends on Pentecost Sunday.

**HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY!** Whereas Mothering Sunday is a religious event celebrated on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, Mother's Day started in the US by Anna Jarvis (1864-1848), in honour of her mother Ann Jarvis (1832-1905).

Ann Jarvis did a lot of Christian charitable work during the American Civil War (1861-65). When she died, her daughter, Anna, called for a special day for people to give thanks for the love, support, encouragement and guidance of their own mother.

In the US, Mother's Day is celebrated on the closest Sunday to Ann's death – 9 May 1905. It is observed on various dates throughout the world. In Spain, it is kept on the 1st Sunday of May – this Sunday – ¡Feliz Día de la Madre!

**PAPAL CONCLAVE:** On Wednesday 7 May, a papal conclave will convene to elect Pope Francis' successor. Please keep the conclave in your prayers.

O God, who in your wondrous love
watches over your Church,
fill the cardinal-electors
with your Holy Spirit to strengthen and inspire them
as they chose a new Pope to lead them.
May they choose a shepherd
who will please you in his holiness
and guide his flock with love and watchful care.
