Notes

1. Baptisms (also called christenings) are usually conducted during Holy Communion in the presence of the whole congregation.
2. It is not essential under Church law for parents to be baptized and confirmed unless they are to be godparents.
3. Parents and godparents should ask themselves:
Am I prepared to the best of my ability to give this child a Christian upbringing within the family of Christ's Church?
Will I help this child to be regular in public worship and in prayer, not only by my teaching but also by my example and my prayers?
Will I encourage the child in due time to come to Confirmation and Communion?
4. It is usual to have three godparents, two of the same gender as the child and one of the opposite sex, but one godfather and one godmother is sufficient.
5. Parents may be godparents to their own children, provided that the child has at least one other godparent.
6. Adult candidates are encouraged to seek baptism, too. It is normal to prepare adults for both Baptism and Confirmation at the same time.
7. It is not possible to be baptized twice. If you have been baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the Spanish Episcopal Church recognises your baptism.
8. By completing and returning this form, you agree that the information provided may be retained solely by the Anglican Church of San Fulgencio for pastoral and archival purposes and not disclosed to any third-party.
